READ for 10 minutes EVERY DAY and talk about your reading with someone at home



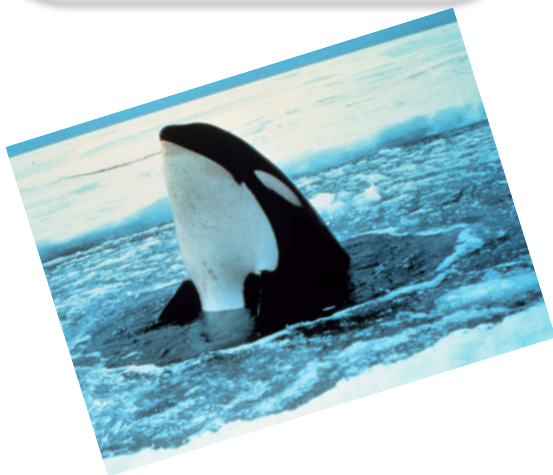
The great debate - current events
