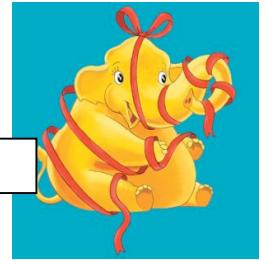


Homethink Week 10
