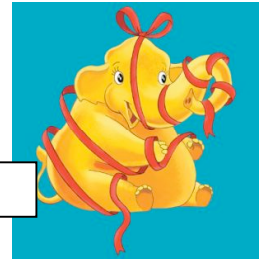


Homethink Week 11

Remember a comma can be used to separate off a group of words that add extra information but can be left out.

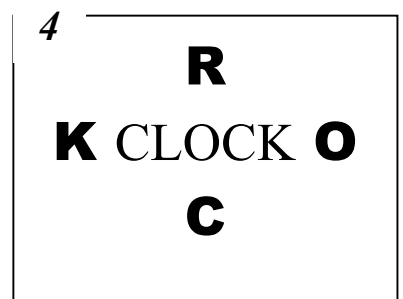
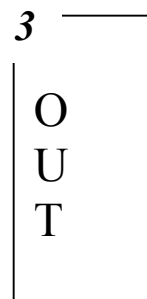
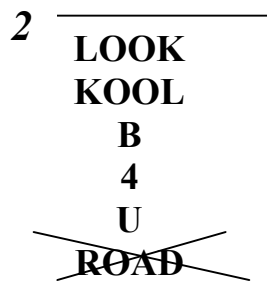
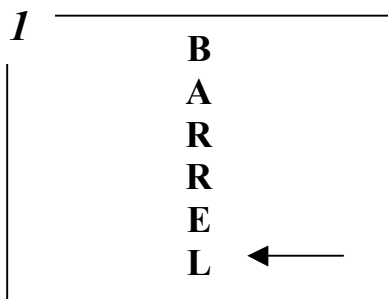
