For this trip we will need 8 parents helpers to come with us on the bus (free of charge) so we'll go with the first 8 we get to make it fair.

All students need to be in their school uniform, with comfortable walking shoes, a jacket just in case, and full lunchbox + drink bottle.

The cost is \$27.50 per child, however if you have 2 children in the māori academy, you will only need to pay once. This will be a very valuable experience for all of our tamariki and we want everyone to attend, hence the early notice.
